

LEADERSHIP PROGRAM DIRECTOR

Circle R Ranch is a year-round outdoor education centre located 8 km west of London, ON. Its mission is to connect people with nature through outdoor recreation and experiential learning. It is a place to make great friends and memories that will last forever. It is a chance to spend quality time in nature while you learn about yourself and the world around you. It is a place where you will be challenged in a way that allows ultimate personal growth. By meeting those challenges, you get to learn skills that will help you anywhere and everywhere in life. We are hiring for a Leadership Program (LP) Director to support the staff who run our leadership programs: Leadership Adventure Program, Leaders in Training, and the Leadership Essentials Program. Participants range from grade 9 to 10. The LP Director would cover time off for the two directors (LIT Director and LAP Director), cover program prep time, help facilitate leadership workshops, ensure quality programming, and other support services. Applicants must be able to facilitate outdoor-based experiences (hikes, basic nature education, etc.) and implement leadership-based lesson plans. This role has a lot of room to get creative to try their own ideas and work together with the other leadership directors to come up with new programs. Must have experience working with youth in grade 9-10, preferably in a teaching or leadership role. Applicants would gain a greater understanding of their own leadership abilities, various life skills, a stronger base of camp-related skills, and the satisfaction of having created lifelong friendships and memories.

Qualifications:

- Positive attitude and willingness to grow personally as a leader
- First Aid and CPR
- Valid Driver's License
- Applicants must have a strong background in counselling & leadership through camp, or related experiences, with preference going to those in a related field in post-secondary education
- Willing to work as a co-director depending on number of applicants
- Time management, organizational skills and the ability to be flexible and adaptable are crucial
- Clear Police Information Check (we have an internal system once you apply)
- Contract dates: Full Time June 24th – September 1st (includes weekly time off)
- Room and board included (Live on-site in a tent)
- Lifeguarding qualifications are assets
