Must have a passion for nature connection, survival skills, teaching about nature, etc. This role also includes program staff, who are responsible for supporting the counselors, running camp programs (archery, canoeing, biking, nature games, active games, farm program, etc.). This involves being creative and resourceful to put together unique, playful, adventurous outdoor-based programs. Applicants would spend most of their time interacting with the kids running programs with some periods for prep time. Time is also spent planning special events to contribute to staff happiness and wellness. Program staff help with camp announcements, taking part in skits, singing camp songs, and more!
